Registration

Kerr Street registered families will receive priority registration until April 22, 2019. Registration will be accepted on a first come, first served basis. All families will be contacted after May 13th to confirm their registration. **Full payment must be received within two weeks of confirmation.** Failure to do so will compromise the children or youth's space in our program.

Kindly give us 3 weeks notice if your child will not be attending the summer program in order to receive a full refund. After 3 weeks, no money will be refunded although your child / youth can transfer to an alternate week up until 1 week before the start of program (space permitting).

Kerr Street Summer Programs provides three options and opportunities for children and youth aged 5 – 15 to participate in a great, structured full day program that focuses on positive, developmentally appropriate activities and fun!

Hours: All programs run Monday – Friday, 9 am – 3 pm (except holidays)
Extended care is available until 4:30 if needed (*pre-registration required*)

Location: Kerr Street Mission - 485 Kerr Street, Oakville

Cost: Registered KSM families \$25/week
Non-Registered families \$125/week
After-Care (Mon-Fri, 3:00-4:30 pm) \$50/week

Option 1: Kerr Street Day Camp (for campers born 2009 - 2014)

Kerr Street Day Camp (KSDC) offers an exciting, high quality summer day camp opportunity for children aged 5-10 years in our neighborhood. Each week will include a new theme filled with traditional camp activities and adventures: games, sports, crafts, songs as well as swimming and special outings.

KSDC is committed to creating a positive environment for campers, staff, and volunteers. Camp is supported by carefully screened and selected staff who are dedicated to high quality, safe and inclusive programming.

Option 2: Kerr Street Youth Program (for youth born 2006 - 2008)

Kerr Street Summer Youth Program offers a fun and interactive program for our youth. They will be encouraged to build new relationships and take part in opportunities to try new things. Our program will include an emphasis on sports and art as well as weekly movie and swimming outings. It will also allow opportunities to volunteer and contribute to the community as well as have fun and participate in experience-based fieldtrips.

Option 3: Leader In Training (for students born 2002 - 2005)

High School Students who are registered for this program can look forward to being mentored by our staff into a leadership role within our day camp and youth programming. This program would be a great fit for those seeking volunteer hours as well as those looking for an amazing training opportunity that will build skills and prepare them for the future. All of our leaders in training will take part in enjoying all of the activities and field trips while learning how to develop their skills as a leader to our campers. Students can use this training towards their volunteer service hours.



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
