Community Investment Campaign

At Kerr Street Mission, we exist to provide care and a community of support for those in Oakville who are struggling and in need - helping improve both their present and their future.

This year, we launched the Community Impact Investment **Campaign** - a bold initiative to expand essential services in Food Security, Mental Health, and Access to Social Supports. These are the areas where help is needed most, and where together, we can create lasting change.

To meet this growing need, we have committed this year to a \$400,000 budget increase. Your gift is more than a donation, it is an investment in real change. Together, we can transform lives and strengthen our community.

Food Security

Food insecurity has reached crisis levels, both Toronto and Mississauga have declared it an emergency, and 40% of food banks across the province have scaled back support due to record-high demand. At Kerr Street Mission, the need is greater than ever, with a staggering 200% increase in families relying on our food market over the past six years.

At Kerr Street Mission, we are committed to ensuring families have access to healthy produce and proteins through our Choose Fresh Program.







Expanded **Food Supply**

Mental Health & Well-Being

Youth mental health is in crisis. In Ontario, 1 in 5 children struggles with mental health, more than half of middle and high school students experience serious psychological distress, and 1 in 6 has considered suicide in the past year. Your support can help change these alarming statistics.

Our new Mental Health & Well-Being resource provides critical support to struggling families in our community through in house programs, 1:1 life coaching and referrals to fully subsidized third party counselling sessions.



Access to **Social Supports**

During times of greatest need, navigating complex social support systems can be overwhelming, especially for families and single parents. Those who receive guidance from a supportive worker will have the greatest success in accessing vital resources. Your support ensures that no one has to navigate these challenges alone.

KSM has added dedicated Family Service resources that will provide personalized guidance, helping families access the social supports they need to transform their lives.

New Sports Camp: Expanding Opportunities for Kids

This summer, Kerr Street Mission's regular camp quickly reached capacity, with 100 spots filled each week. To meet the demand and give more children the chance to learn, grow, and play, we partnered with King's Christian Collegiate, Oakville Soccer Club, Titans Football Club, and others to launch a new three-week Sports Camp. The result was a tremendous success - children discovered new passions, built confidence, and experienced the joy of community through sport.

Given the strong demand and positive feedback, Kerr Street Mission is excited to expand Sports Camp even further next summer, opening doors for even more kids to thrive.

Kerr Street Mission is committed to equipping Oakville youth with the tools, confidence, and opportunities they need to thrive. Our **Leaders in Training (LIT) Program**, delivered in partnership with the renowned Muskoka Woods Leadership Studio, develops essential life and leadership skills for high school students. The program is **fully subsidized**, ensuring that youth from under-resourced families can access these transformative experiences.

The LIT Program is a cornerstone of Kerr Street Mission's youth development pathway. Many graduates return as camp counsellors and leaders, creating a powerful cycle of mentorship. In fact, a significant number are hired back to inspire the next generation multiplying the impact across our community.





Volunteers are at the heart of Kerr Street Mission. Every program, every meal served, every smile shared is made possible because people in our community choose to give their time and talents to care for others. From stocking shelves in the Market, to serving a hot meal, to mentoring youth, to welcoming newcomers with warmth and dignity - our volunteers make KSM a place of belonging and hope.

The impact goes far beyond tasks completed. Volunteers form relationships, build trust, and remind struggling neighbours that they are not alone. In turn, many volunteers tell us how deeply rewarding it is to be part of this work - how serving at Kerr Street Mission has given them purpose, perspective, and joy.
